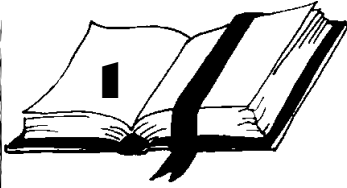

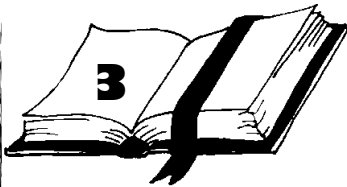

We wait with eager hope for the day when God will give us our full rights as his adopted children, including the new bodies he has promised us. We were given this hope when we were saved.

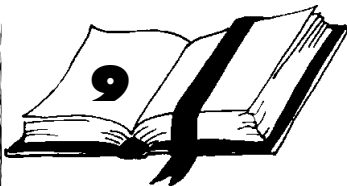

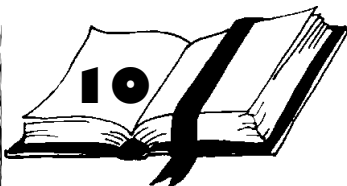

Worship Christ as Lord of your life. And if someone asks about your hope as a believer, always be ready to explain it.

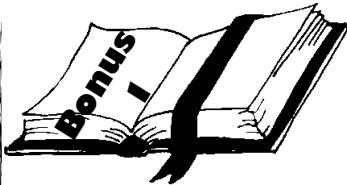

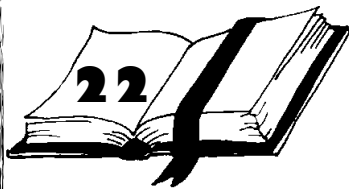

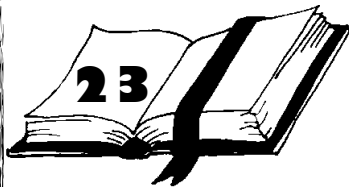
