always perseveres.

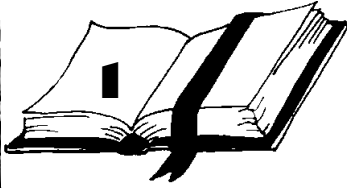
Love never fails...

Three things will last forever - faith, hope, and love - and the greatest of these is love.

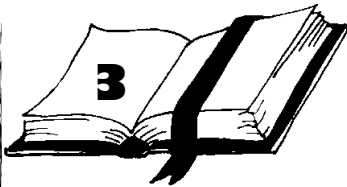

We who are strong must be considerate of those who are sensitive about things. We must not just please ourselves. For even Christ didn't live to please himself.

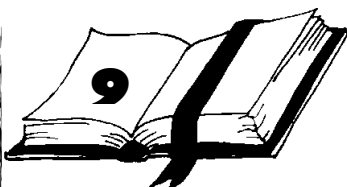

You have been called to live in freedom. But don't use your freedom to satisfy your sinful nature. Instead, use your freedom to serve one another in love.

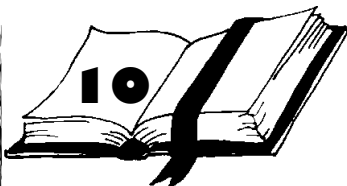

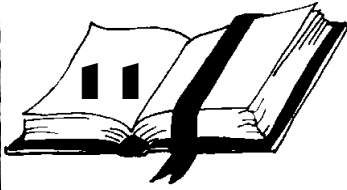


Ephesians

Don't sin by letting anger control you. Don't let the sun go down while you are still angry, for anger gives a foothold to the devil.

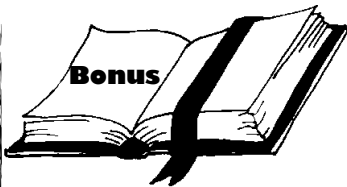

Don't use foul or abusive language. Let everything you say be good and helpful, so that your words will be an encouragement to those who hear them.

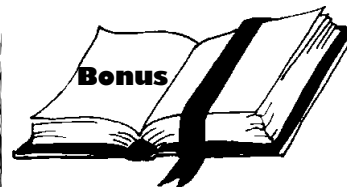

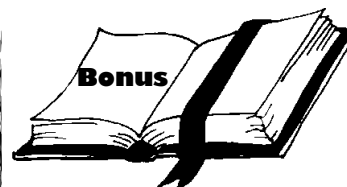

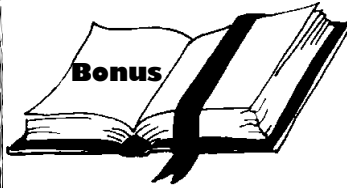


**Philippians

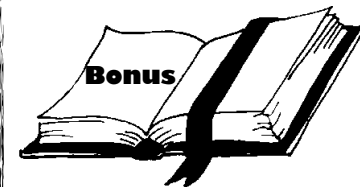

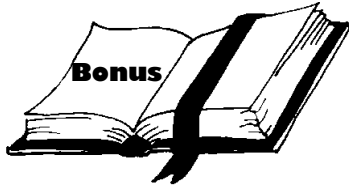


**1 Peter

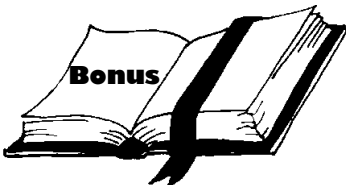
TERM 3 SCRIPTURE MEMORY

You were cleansed from your sins when you obeyed the truth, so now you must show sincere love to each other. Love each other deeply with all your heart.

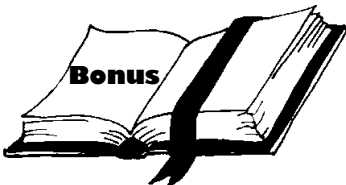
